INTRODUCTION

The **Southeast Asian Zoos & Aquariums Association (SEAZA)** is a non-profit, non-governmental organisation of zoological institutions in the Southeast Asian Region. SEAZA institutional members are zoological institutions coming from ASEAN member and observer nations (Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam, and Timor Leste) as well as from regional neighbours Hong Kong and Taiwan. SEAZA was founded in 1990 and is a Regional Association Member of the World Association of Zoos & Aquariums (WAZA).

The primary purpose of SEAZA, as an organisation, is to promote among its members:

1. Adherence to appropriate *ex situ* animal management standards and best practices; and
2. To significantly contribute to wildlife science and education advancement, as well as to biodiversity and wildlife habitat conservation initiatives, especially in the Southeast Asian Region.

DECLARATION OF AGREEMENT

COMMITMENT TO THE SEAZA CODE OF WELFARE AND ETHICS

INTRODUCTION

To promote high standards of animal welfare, the Southeast Asian Zoos and Aquariums Association (SEAZA) adopts global best practices that incorporate the “Five Domains” model. SEAZA upholds positive animal welfare standards by keeping abreast of and implementing continually evolving practices.

To this end, SEAZA, through the Animal Welfare and Ethics Committee, created the SEAZA Code of Welfare and Ethics. This Code, endorsed by the World Association of Zoos and Aquariums (WAZA) in 2023, embodies the guiding principles for upholding the well-being of animals under our care.

DECLARATION OF COMMITMENT

We, _____, confirm that we have read and understood the SEAZA Code of Welfare and Ethics and the SEAZA Standards on Animal Welfare and will, hereinafter, agree to the following provisions:

- 1. We commit to adhere to the SEAZA Code of Welfare and Ethics and the SEAZA Standards on Animal Welfare and any future amendments to the same as agreed upon by the SEAZA membership at the General Assembly;
- 2. We acknowledge that adherence to the Code and the Standards shall be monitored by SEAZA through the Membership and Animal Welfare and Ethics Committees;
- 3. We understand that failure to comply with the provisions of the Code and the Standards can result in disciplinary action and possible suspension of membership; and
- 4. We acknowledge that the SEAZA Board's decisions regarding non-compliance are final.
